# Check who sees your posts

There are some basic privacy settings that you need to take a look at to make sure they work well for you, starting with looking at who can see your stuff.

- 1 Click the **Question Mark** icon in the top-right corner, and select **Settings**
- 2 Click **Privacy** from the left-hand menu
- 3 You have four options available to you:

- **Who can see your future posts?** Click **Edit**, and choose the group of people you'd like to open or limit your posts to.
  - **Who can see your friends list?** Click **Edit**, and choose who should see your list. Selecting **Only me** ensures others can only view your mutual friends.
  - **Review all your posts and things you're tagged in** Click **Use Activity Log**, and you will be shown a list of stories you have been mentioned in. You can select to **Hide items** or **Add to Timeline**.
  - **Limit the audience for posts you've shared with friends of friends or Public?** By selecting this and clicking **Limit Past Posts**, every past post will only be viewable by **Friends** unless you have tagged people, in which case they and their friends will be able to view too.
- 4 Click **Close** when you have finished with each section. You are now able to move on to who can contact you and look you up
