



The Settings app has been comprehensively updated for Android 7.0 Nougat.



The Settings app can be added to the Home screen, or the Favorites Tray (see page 56), by pressing and holding on it in the All Apps section and then dragging it to the required location.



The Settings app can also be accessed by swiping down from the top of the phone to access the Quick Settings (see page 54). From here, tap on the **Settings** button at the top of the screen.



Accessing Settings

We all like to think of ourselves as individuals, and this extends to the appearance and operation of our electronic gadgets. An Android phone offers a range of settings so that you can set it up exactly the way that you want, and give it your own look and feel. These are available from the **Settings** app.

To access the **Settings** app on your Android phone:

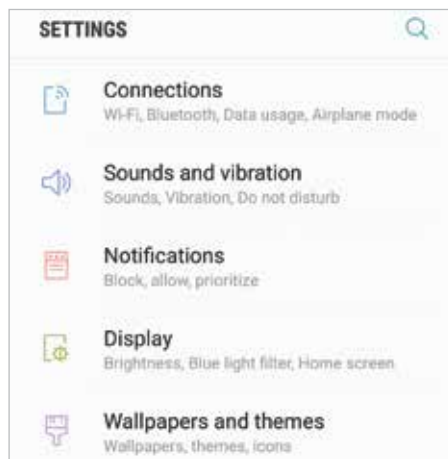
- 1 Tap on the **All Apps** button (see page 56)



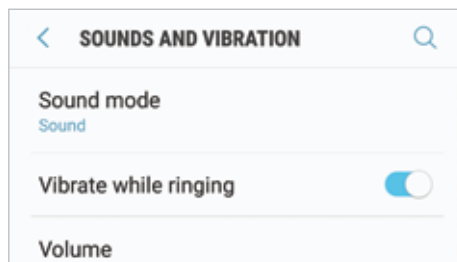
- 2 Tap on the **Settings** app
