
Toolbars


Dreamweaver CS6 has a number of toolbars, which contain several options for specifying how the program operates. By default, these are displayed at the top of the page, although they can also be dragged to other locations. The toolbars can be accessed by selecting View, Toolbars, from the menu bar.

The two most commonly used toolbars are the Document toolbar, which contains the workspaces and views, and the Standard toolbar. The features of these include:

Another element of the Document toolbar is the Title box. This is where you enter the document title, which appears at the top of a web browser when a page is published online.

Browse in Bridge takes you to Adobe Bridge, which is a stand-alone program for browsing files, and looking for shared assets, particularly images, in other programs.



The other available toolbar is Style Rendering, for creating pages for different output devices.
