Dreamweaver Help


The main help index is displayed in a browser window. This has a variety of options, all of which are accessed from the Help button on the menu bar:

Select Help,
Dreamweaver Help,
from the menu bar,

and select a topic



The related item is opened in the online Adobe Community Help pages. Use the Search box to find items





The Help menu also has an option for registering your copy of Dreamweaver. This is done online, by connecting to the Adobe website. Once you have gone through the registration process, you will be able to get technical support for the product, and also receive the latest information about updates and upgrades.



The help files can be accessed by pressing F1 on the keyboard.
