# Hot tip

Control the size of the Mini Bridge window by placing your cursor on the left, right or bottom edge of the floating panel. Drag when you see the bidirectional resize arrow. By changing the size of the panel you can arrange the Content Pod to the right of the Navigator Pod or below it.



## Hot tip

Use the pop-up menus in the Content Bar to select, sort and filter the contents of the Content Pod as you can in Adobe Bridge (see pages 17–19):






Click once on an image or pdf thumbnail to select it, then press the Spacebar to show a full screen preview of the file. Press the Spacebar again to hide the preview.


## Mini Bridge


Mini Bridge provides a similar range of functionality to Adobe Bridge, but from within the InDesign working environment. Choose Window>Mini Bridge to show the panel.

- Click the Browse
  Files button to
  begin using Mini
  Bridge. Clicking the
  Browse Files button
  also launches Bridge
  in the background as
  Mini Bridge operations
  rely on Bridge to carry
  out tasks.
- Use the Panel View
  pop-up menu to
  control the visibility of the Path
  Bar and the Navigation and
  Preview Pods.



- 4 Drag the Thumbnail Size slider, at the bottom of the panel, to control the size of thumbnail previews in the Content Pod.
- Click the View button at the bottom of the panel to specify the arrangement and appearance of file thumbnails.





- To open an InDesign document from Mini Bridge double-click the thumbnail icon.
- To place an image into the currently active InDesign document drag an image thumbnail onto the InDesign page. When you release the mouse button the Loaded Graphics cursor





If you double-click an image thumbnail in Mini Bridge the image opens in Photoshop.

appears. You can now place the image (see page 88 for further information on placing images). When you place

an image from Mini Bridge, InDesign forms a link to the image as it does when you use the File>Place command.

To see a larger preview for a selected image thumbnail in the Preview Pod, hold down Shift then press the Spacebar. Click the Close button to return to thumbnails view.





### Hot tip



You can also use the Tools button ( 🛼 )in the Content bar to place the selected thumbnail. Click the Tools button, then select Place>In InDesign.





To see a full screen slideshow of all images in the Preview Pod, make sure that none of the images are selected. Click the Slideshow button ( ■▼ ). Whilst the slideshow is running, press H on the keyboard to display on-screen commands for controlling the slideshow.
