Hot tip

Some selfie sticks double up as tripods, which can be used to keep the smartphone steady when taking a photo, or when using the self-timer.



Some selfie sticks use a detachable remote control for taking photos. It can be used in position on the selfie stick as in Step 5, or it can be removed and used away from the smartphone, and does not have to be attached to the selfie stick.



Bluetooth Selfie Sticks

Bluetooth selfie sticks are slightly more sophisticated than their cable counterparts, but they perform the same task. However, the connection between the smartphone and the selfie stick is a wireless Bluetooth one, rather than a physical one with a cable. To use a Bluetooth selfie stick:


- Attach the smartphone to the selfie stick's top clamp (this will be the same as for a cable selfie stick, except that there is no cable)
- Tap on the **Bluetooth** option in your smartphone's settings



Turn **On** the **Bluetooth** option and tap on the selfie stick name when it appears



Tap on the **Pair** button to link the smartphone and the Bluetooth selfie stick, so that they can communicate



Open the smartphone's Camera app and press the Shutter button on the selfie stick to take a photo
