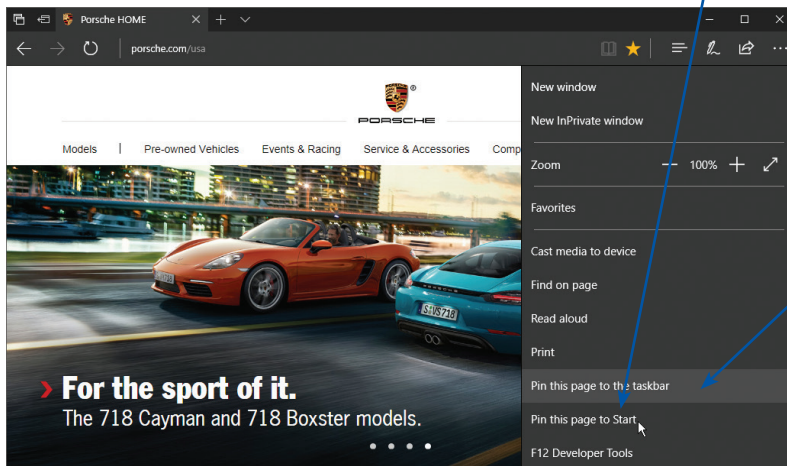


Pinning websites

A website that you are likely to visit frequently can alternatively be made quickly accessible as a link pinned to the Start menu:

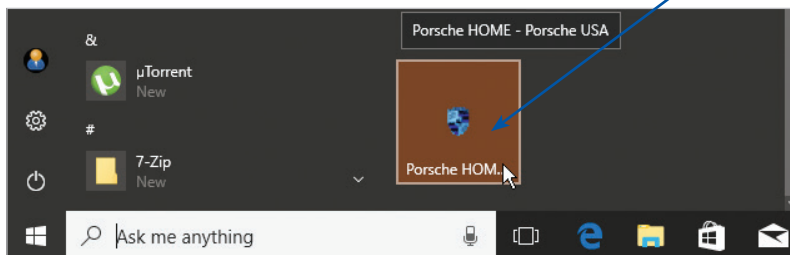
- 1 Open the website in the Microsoft Edge browser
- 2 Click the ellipsis (...) **More** button
- 3 On the **More** menu, choose the **Pin this page to Start** option to create a link to the current website



- 4 Confirm you want to pin this tile to the Start menu by clicking the **Yes** button



- 5 Open the Start menu, then click on the link tile to launch Microsoft Edge and open that website once more

The Windows 10 Fall Creators Update added the option to pin web pages to the taskbar.



You can scroll down the menu to find an option to **Open with Internet Explorer** for legacy websites that do not perform well in the Microsoft Edge browser.



You can remove any tile from the Start menu, including a pinned link, by right-clicking on it then choosing **Unpin from Start** from the context menu.
