

Add a Style Sheet

1 Start an HTML file with a document type declaration
`<!DOCTYPE HTML>`

2 Add a root element containing head and body sections
`<html lang="en" >`
`<head>`
`<meta charset="UTF-8" >`
`<title>Style</title>`
`<!-- Style Sheet to replace this comment. -->`
`</head>`
`<body>`
`<!-- Content to replace this comment. -->`
`</body>`
`</html>`

3 In the body section, insert a heading and a list
`<h1>Most Valuable NFL Teams</h1>`

`New England Patriots`
`Washington Redskins`
`Los Angeles Rams`
``

4 In the head section, insert a style sheet
`<style>`
`h1 { color:blue; background:yellow }`
`ol { list-style-image:url(helmet-bullet.png) }`
`</style>`

5 Save the HTML document, then open the web page in your browser to see the style rules get applied

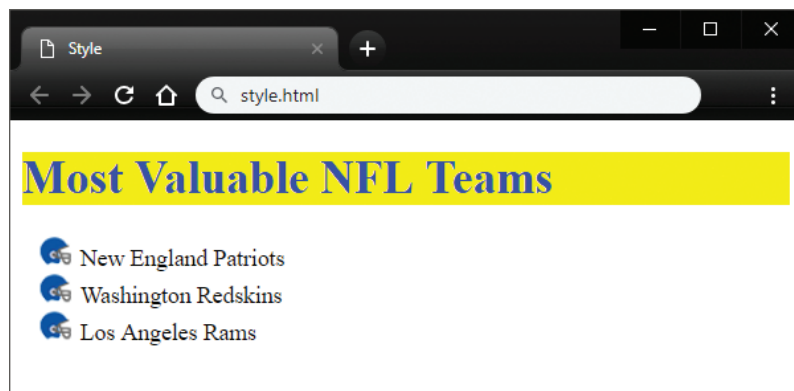

In the name, “cascading” refers to how styles cascade (flow down) to elements contained inside the element that the rule selected – here, from the `` element down to `` elements.
