

Using WebBrowser

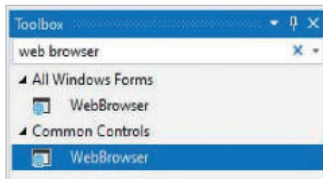
The Visual Basic **WebBrowser** control makes it simple to quickly add a document viewer to your application, which can view HTML documents both online and on your own computer. It can also display plain text and image files – just like your web browser.



SimpleBrowser

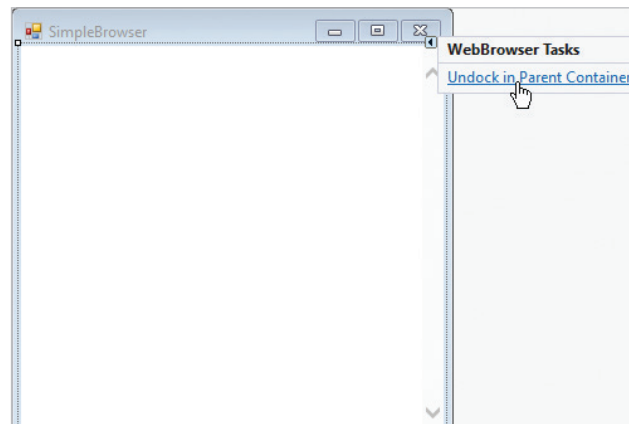


You can use the Search box in the Toolbox to find the **WebBrowser** control.



Grab the handles around the controls to resize them on the Form.

- 1 Add a **WebBrowser** control to a Form – it will automatically occupy the entire Form area
- 2 Click on the **Smart Tag** arrow button and select the **Undock in Parent Container** link



- 3 Add a **TextBox** and **Button** control, then arrange the Form controls to look like this:
